

Useful information

We aim to provide a safe, stimulating and happy environment for each child in our care.

- Nursery doors open at 8.45am, closing at 9.00am. If your child is doing a morning session without lunch they can be collected from the Office between 11.45am. If your child is doing a morning session with lunch they can be collected from the Nursery at 1pm. If your child is doing a whole day session they can be collected at 3.15pm from the bottom of the Nursery steps. (While your child settles in, you are welcome to pick-up from 3.00pm by ringing the doorbell rather than waiting for home time.)
- We provide a healthy fruit snack and milk/ water at 10.00am and your child has access to their own named water bottle with fresh water throughout the day. Lunch is at 11.45am for Nursery where we get our lunch before the rest of the school in the hall to ensure a calm lunchtime.
- Forest School is a half-day session, usually an afternoon (day to be confirmed for September 2016) where the children enjoy hands-on outdoor learning opportunities in our natural surroundings. This is led by our own Forest School-qualified leader and gives the children the chance to explore and investigate the outdoors. We provide waterproofs to go over the children's clothing but ask that you send your child in weather-appropriate clothing that covers arms and legs against stings, as well as with their own pair of wellies.
- At 'OK Club' we provide a Breakfast Club (8.00am-8.45am) and an After-School Club until 5.30pm that run out of the Nursery building, should you require wraparound care to suit your working hours.



What to wear to Nursery

You can choose to purchase the Little Pippins polo shirt and sweatshirt as optional Nursery uniform (pictured below). These are available to buy from the school office.



Other than this, please ensure that your child wears comfortable clothing. We get involved in lots of fun, messy play and outside activities, so suitable clothing is very important! This includes a warm, waterproof coat and sensible, comfy shoes that the children can put on and take off easily.

What to bring

- A rucksack with a complete change of clothes (all named)
- A named pair of wellies (ideally to be kept at Nursery)
- Sun cream & sun hat in warm weather (named)
- Hat, scarf & gloves in cold weather (named)
- If your child uses nappies or pull-ups, please provide enough nappies and wipes for each day in their bag.

*We provide a named water bottle for your child which is kept at Nursery.
